Picture Day



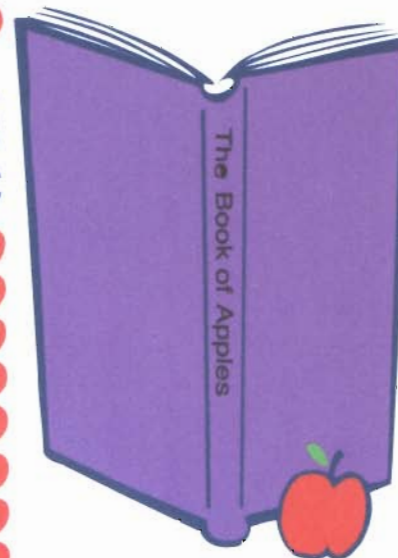
