



# Apostles Lutheran Preschool

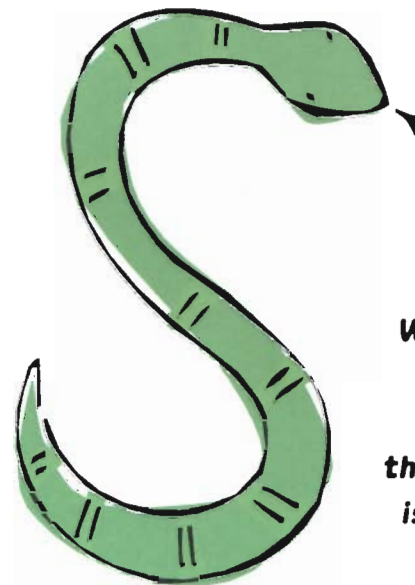
## October 20 - 22, 2009



The theme this week was about personal safety. We learned what an emergency was and then learned when it is okay to call 911 and when it is not. We practiced dialing 911 on our pretend phone and discussed that we cannot practice on a real phone. We also talked about "Stranger Danger." We first have to decide what a stranger is and then why we never talk to people we do not know. If someone is bothering you it is okay to loudly say NO and run away.

The highlight of the week was having Officer Z. from the Billings Police force come and visit us. He showed a quick movie about gun safety and taught the children a song to remind them...."Stop don't touch, leave the area, tell an adult." He also let the children check out his police cruiser and hear his siren. We also let the children know that a policeman is your friend.

Our Bible lesson this week was how God lead His people through the Red Sea. We hear how God's special plan for Moses was to be leader of His people, the Isrealites. God helped Moses lead them out of Egypt. Ask your child what God put in the sky to lead the people during the day and then at night. Then ask what happened when Pharaoh decided to come after them. We hear how God protects His people. The Bible treasure this week - "Call on me in the day of trouble."
